Swim England Club Hub

This hub contains everything you need to know about club finances, managing volunteers and club staff, and marketing your club.

It also includes a link to the <u>Swim England Handbook</u>, which contains Regulation 150, the internal club disputes procedure.

Return to Training Guidance Updated

A guidance document for <u>Returning to Training for Coaches</u> has been produced. Although not all clubs will have access to facilities immediately as some pools are delaying reopening, this guidance is available now to enable

plans to be prepared so athletes don't suffer injuries on their return.

The document includes coaching, physiology, psychology, strength and conditioning, nutrition and physiotherapy tips. Specific discipline guidance will be appearing in the appendices in the near future.



Some Positive News!




Volunteers and teachers and coaches all over the region have been working really hard to make sure clubs are ready to get back into the pool when circumstances allow.
