#### Stronger Affiliation

ALL CLUBS MUST BE EITHER SWIMMARK ACCREDITED, OR HAVE COMPLETED <u>STRONGER AFFILIATION</u> BY THE END OF THE YEAR TO AFFILIATE FOR 2021.

The online portal is now live so clubs can begin uploading the essential evidence for affiliation in Jan 2021. If your club has SwimMark, you don't need to do anything else.

#### **Regional Swimming Talent Camp**



Many of you will be aware the Regional Talent Programme usually operates in the autumn each year for up to 36 twelve year-olds (age as of end of year) to access three camps. Due to the pandemic, this year we are going to deliver a digital version of the development programme. This will enable the region to open up the learning to a bigger cohort of 2008 born swimmers.

#### **Data Collection on Return to Training**

Swim England has asked all clubs to help with the collecting of data to give a rolling picture of the status of returning to training.

Clubs can access the link at any time and it will display previously entered data

if the club uses the same entry point and the same browser so clubs do not need to repeat the data entry. Clubs are encouraged to update data as the status of returning changes.
