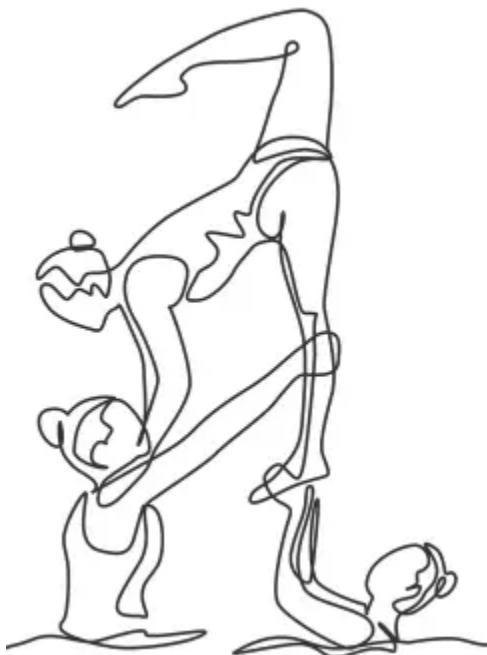
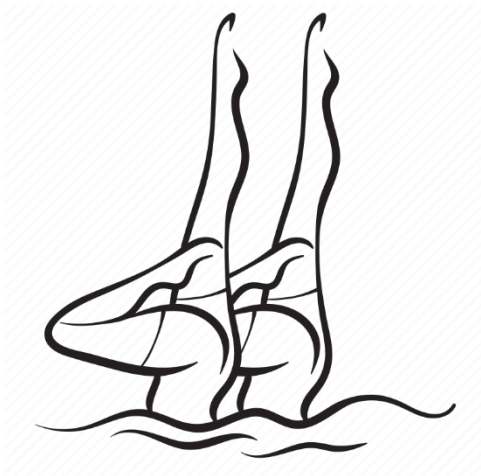

## NOTE FROM THE REFEREE

To all in attendance,

Welcome and thank you for coming to support our swimmers today! There are just a few things that I would like to remind you about as we enter into the new format for judging artistic swimming in 2024.

I would like to raise it to your attention that those people who give up their time to judge/score/clerk/call/volunteer to be on poolside at competition do so for the love of the sport and they want to help future generations to enjoy it. Therefore, can everyone please ensure they are treated with respect, kindness and gratitude on the day and afterwards. This includes comments from parents and coaches. Please ensure you support these volunteers as without them none of this is possible.

They have all had to go through many hours of retraining, and in some cases months, in order for our region to have the different roles filled.

If there are any problems, you may speak to your Team Manager (TM) about it and they, and they alone, can come and speak to me at the event.

Please also note that only TM's are allowed in the changing room - all have been DBS checked and have attended TM training and a safeguarding courses.

### **The new system:**

Figures:

Previous scores for figures are now somewhat irrelevant, so please do not compare marks to future scores if possible.

Figure scores are now heavily weighed on height within a figure or flexibility, therefore please be aware that scores may be lower than they would have been previously for figures. The judges will be sat with a table and have many height charts in front of them to assist with this.

Although the height charts give a starting mark for the figure please do note the marks on those charts is only for the height, it doesn't take into consideration other deductions for design fault - e.g. angle being off from vertical.

We hope all coaches and parents have shared this with swimmers so they are not disheartened by what may be deemed a low mark. We must remember that team GB are scoring 8's and therefore we must acknowledge we are not all at this level yet and many are still on their journey.

Routines:

This will look very different on poolside, there will be an overall TC (Technical Controller) and they will look over the coaching cards submitted.

Judges marks for this will go in increments of 0.25 from 0-10.

Judges who are on Artistic Impression will give 3 marks, one for each of the following:

- choreography and musicality
- performance
- transitions

Then there will be a Synchronisation TC panel (3 judges) (duets/teams/combos only), who whilst watching the routine, will be marking off (tallying) small, obvious and major synchronisation errors.

For this competition the difficulty score will be set at the base mark for all hybrids.

Therefore these scores will also look very different.

So as you can see there will be a lot of brain power going on and timings due to this may be longer than expected potentially.

Therefore we ask for patience and kindness throughout the event to all, including your TM's and coaches, they are no more in the know about timings and are once again there to support your swimmers.

We will need a quiet environment for all events, phones on silent no other background noise from viewing gallery such as tablets etc.

We are all there to help the swimmers and I hope we can create an environment that is one where they feel they know what they are entering and that we are all there as a collective to support them in achieving the best they can.
