Swim England Foundations of Inclusivity online module



The aim of this eLearning CPD is to provide individuals with the foundations of inclusivity to enable a change in mindset by adopting the social approach of inclusion in a range of environments. It will give you an introduction to equality, diversity and inclusion, covering the path to inclusion, the use of appropriate language and the importance of adaption.

It is recommended for club Chairs, Welfare Officers, Team managers and Coaches and teachers.

Foundations-of-inclusivity online module

Club Chair and Welfare Officer Workshops

These <u>free workshops</u> are now mandatory for all club chairs and welfare officers.

The Chair workshop is designed to share important information with Chairs on dealing with internal disputes, highlighting the governing document/constitution and how this should support decisions and processes as well as overall good governance

The Welfare Officer workshop is designed to further support experienced or new Welfare Officers in dealing with club issues surrounding the welfare of children in given situations. The workshop will build on

knowledge already gained through attendance on both the Safeguarding and Time to Listen workshops. Masters Welfare Leads are currently exempt from attending the WO workshop.

Purpose of the EDLG

The purpose of the EDLG is to plan and manage an effective structure of Diving competitions and to ensure the effective development of Diving within the region in accordance with the Swim England East Region Strategy and Development Plan and compatible with Swim England structures.

Aims of the EDLG

- 1. To operate an annual programme of regional competitions in Diving, in line with Swim England agreements and approved plans and budgets
- 2. To ensure appropriate structures are in place to support the development of Diving within the region
- 3. To ensure that an appropriate workforce is in place to support the development of Diving
- 4. To ensure that talented athletes are identified and supported to achieve their potential

Objective of the ELDG

- 1. To identify required developments to enable an effective athlete pathway to be in place throughout the region
- 2. To run regional competitions for appropriate age groups
- 3. To run regional development camps, as required and on a cost-neutral basis, to support and identify talented athletes and coaches
- 4. To identify workforce requirements for officials, coaches and other club personnel
- 5. To develop officials, and other volunteers, to support the regional competition requirements

Responsibilities

- 1. Producing an annual plan and budget to meet the objectives
- 2. Submitting the annual plan and budget to the ROC for approval and to the Board for final agreement
- 3. Implementing the agreed plan within the allocated budget, or agreeing on any deviations with the Board
- 4. Advising the Regional Development Manager of requirements for coach and club development, and education requirements, to enable the successful implementation of the plan
- 5. All communications should be copied to the representative from the Regional Operations Committee
