

The winners will be put forward for the National Swim England Awards 2023 being held inside the Great Hall at Birmingham University on Saturday 18th November.




Swim England Updated Reporting for Licensed Meet Results

Swim England has now introduced a new automated process to support meet promoters in the uploading of results, without the need to mail results to the rankings team

Swim England has created an automated process that speeds up this process and gives control to the Promoters to upload results via https://resultsuploader.swimming.org/.

If the uploaded results have no errors, they will automatically be uploaded to Rankings within 1-2 hours, reducing the time from potentially days to hours. Refer to the below diagram for the new process.





Club Health Tracker

Following the successful launch of the club health tracker earlier this year, the next window for completing the tracker will open later this month.

The tracker, delivered by Sporting Insights, is an online tool for clubs to easily examine their development work and hone in on any of the six core areas of club life – coaching and teaching, financial management, pool operator relationships, governance and standards, growth, and volunteers.

The window for submissions will open later this October, so please keep your eyes peeled on your emails for the latest updates.

DBS and Safeguarding Requirements Reminder



As part of Swim England and the Region's commitment to safeguarding and welfare, from 1 January 2024, any coach or teacher whose DBS and Safeguarding expires will not be allowed poolside unsupervised.

The changes will be published in Wavepower 2024, with greater detail.

Please ensure all coaches, teachers and relevant volunteers are up to date with their qualifications and DBS.

Please can we ask all club committees to ensure that the contact details for their Officers are correct on their OMS portal and that individual contact details for Officers and members are accurate and up to date.

New guidance to help identify warning signs of low energy availability



New guidance to help coaches, athletes and parents identify the warning signs of low energy availability has been published by Swim England.

Low energy availability occurs when athletes don't eat enough calories to meet their training demands, resulting in the body not having enough energy to support all physiological functions needed to maintain optimal health.

It can be the first sign of an eating disorder or disordered eating and the guidance includes important information on the physical, psychological or behavioural symptoms associated with low energy availability.


