Club Reports

24/30.1 <u>Luton</u>

BL reported positive movements at the club with a new committee and former Chair John Cripps taking on the chair role again. Jack Tempest was in the role of Assistant Head Coach. A revamped LTD programme was now in place along with a new timetable. New kit was being put in place and the SwimMark health check had been completed. Potential new squad divers were also being tested. One diver had qualified for National Skills Finals. Some of their existing divers were currently undergoing the Assistant Coaching Course (Level 1). On the negative side, the pool bubbles were out of action.

24/30.2 <u>Southend</u>

SL reported that the club continued to progress well. Boards had been fixed and lights upgraded. Foam for new dryland facility would be delivered shortly and the club now had a date for installation of the new fulcrums for the 2 x 3m boards. SL asked again about availability of regional funding. LT commented that she was aware that funding from the region had been discussed at Board level but did not have a recent update on progress. It was understood that the region had requested a statement of initial costs and also clarification of ongoing maintenance costs and how would be covered. IMK was not aware of any further developments either.

24/30.3 <u>Cambridge</u>

AJ reported steady progress on growing LTD numbers which remained so critical to financing the clubs wider squad activities and discussions were ongoing with Tadhg Owers about becoming the club's third professional coach. Training camps were planned over the summer in both Birmingham and Southend to give opportunity to as many squad members as possible. Getting support from DiveGym for ongoing maintenance of facility development remained frustrating but some progress was being made.

24/30.4 <u>Dacorum</u>

SG reported ongoing issues with bubbles facility at the pool but that Everyone Active was being supportive of the club.

Action: LT to check if she can identify supplier for repair of pool bubbles.

24/31 Operations Update

24/31.1 SB reported a successful Age Groups event from financial perspective with a surplus of around £700. The EDLG approved her recommendation to purchase additional medals going forward to be able to give to guests too as the current supply had run out. Action: SB
